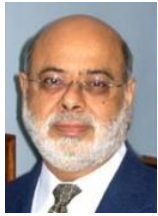

Dr. R. Shyam Khemani, Ph.D. in Economics from The London School of Economics, specialises in providing applied economic analysis, litigation support and economic research services to law firms, corporations, government and trade associations on complex competition and regulatory matters.

Until recently, he was Advisor, Competition Policy, in the Financial & Private Sector Development Vice-Presidency of the World Bank Group, Washington D.C. He has advised governments and business in over two dozen industrial and developing countries on various competition, regulation, micro-industrial economics, and international trade issues.

He served as Director, Law & Economics Consulting Group (LECG) European operations and also worked with the Canadian Competition Bureau. He also contributed to the work of two Royal Commissions in Canada dealing with issues of industrial concentration, competition policy, competitiveness and economic growth. He also served as an Advisor to the Chairman, Raghavan committee in regards to drafting of **India's new competition law and policy**. He is member on various advisory boards of internationally renowned organisations including CIRC.

Dr. Khemani has published monographs, articles in various journals (e.g., Journal of Industrial Economics, International Journal of Industrial Organization, Antitrust Bulletin, Applied Economics, Policy Options, etc.), and co-edited books on competition policy.



Dr Frédéric Jenny is Professor of Economics at ESSEC Business School in Paris, Judge at the Supreme Court of France (Cour de Cassation), Chairman of the OECD Competition Law and Policy Committee.

Dr Frédéric Jenny studied in France and the United States and holds a Doctorate in sciences Economiques (University of Paris) and a Ph.D in economics (Harvard University). He has written extensively on Industrial Organization, Competition law, Trade and Economic Development.

He has been a member of various US and international academic and competition law institutes/bodies. He is also the President of Advisory board of CUTS -CCIER.
