#### Telecom Right of Way rules must for states from January 1

Effective January 1, 2025, the Department of Telecommunications (DoT) enforced updated Right of Way rules to streamline the deployment of telecommunications infrastructure. States were required to upgrade their RoW portals to align with these new regulations, aiming to expedite approvals for tower installations and optical fiber deployments

# TRAI releases Draft Telecommunication Tariff Order, 2025 on "Rationalization of Broadband Tariffs for PDOs under PM-WANI Scheme"

On January 15, 2025, TRAI issued the Draft Telecommunication Tariff (Seventy-First Amendment) Order, 2025, focusing on the rationalization of broadband tariffs for Public Data Offices (PDOs) under the PM-WANI scheme. This amendment proposes that tariffs for broadband connectivity provided to PDOs should not exceed twice the rates applicable for retail broadband Fiber-to-the-Home (FTTH) services of corresponding capacity.

#### Draft Telecommunications (Radio Equipment Possession Authorization) Rules, 2025

These draft rules aim to regulate the possession and use of radio equipment, ensuring compliance with national security and spectrum management policies. Stakeholders were invited to provide feedback on these draft rules.
