Qualifications

Educational requirements

- Bachelor's degree from a reputed institution
- Full-time masters in social sciences/ political science/ public policy/ public administration/ law, journalism or related discipline

Relevant experience

- Background of working on similar national or international projects in think tank/ academic institute/ NGO or corporate environment
- Record of 2-3 publications of research writing out of which at least 2 must be independent (one of these could be an unpublished piece/ work submitted for publication at the level of a master's dissertation)

Core competencies

- Fair understanding of infrastructure sector in India including functioning of PPPs
- Strong grasp of social sector and/or public policy and/ or corporate strategy
- Excellent writing skills
- Personal strengths must include professional attitude and disciplined, receptive mindset
- Approaching and seeking timely assistance when requirements are unclear
